## Liskeard Neighbourhood Plan (2015 - 2030)

## AIM

Liskeard Employability Group aims to ensure the town's long term sustainability as a modern market town and to create sufficient employment to ensure it does not become a dormitory town for nearby towns & cities.

This will be achieved by:

- · Identifying appropriate physical locations for employment/training development within the Liskeard Parish
- Providing both local employment opportunities and a range of services to the people living in the town and to those living in the surrounding villages and countryside
- Balancing the number for new homes with number of new jobs particularly with regard to private new housing developments.
- · Encouraging and supporting the development of local employment hubs
- · Building on existing services
- · Seeking to encourage a strong, broad-based employment growth strategy
- · Operating broadly in line with the local development plan
- Promoting/securing (local) investments
- Supporting and encouraging the co-ordination of vocational training/skills development between formal education and private sector
- Developing mechanisms for debate/discussions as part of planning applications through meetings with stakeholders and neighbouring Parishes
- · Considering ways to improve a sustainable transport infrastructure
- Actively encourage the development of sustainable and environmentally "green" business (low impact)
