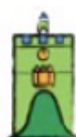

There will be the opportunity to discuss relevant application of many of the ideas presented on the Friday, to talk with speakers in smaller groups and extend the debate. : We will cover a range of possibilities, including Self Build - in its many varieties, shared homes and co-housing and financial opportunities/constraints for different models of housing provision.

Our aim is to inspire those involved in Neighbourhood Planning processes throughout Devon and Cornwall; communities, councillors, planners, architects and land owners.
