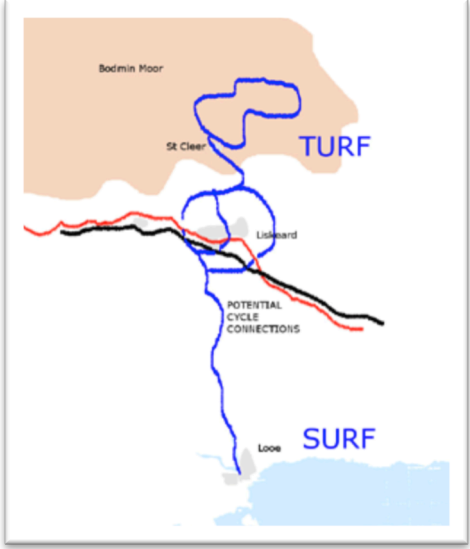
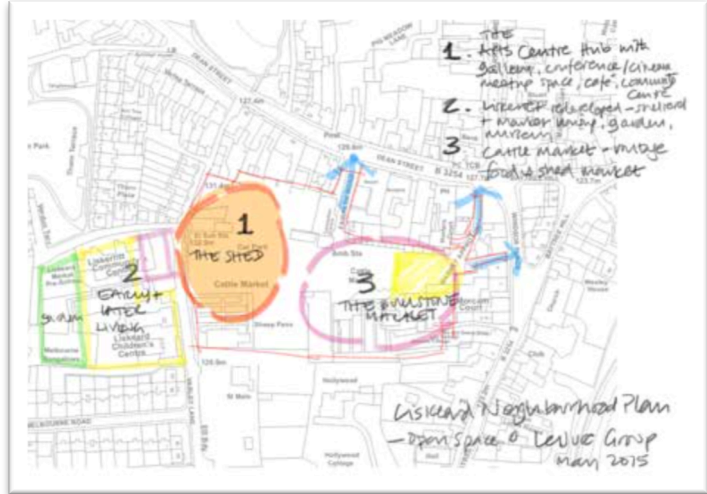
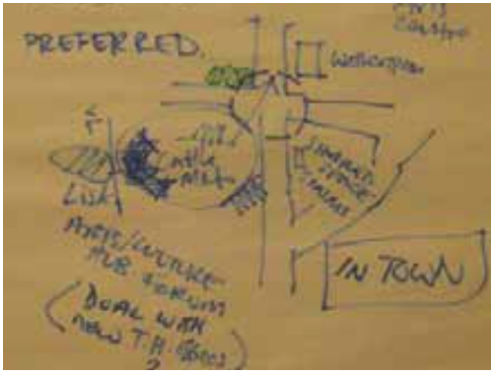

What do you think about creating a new park at the Roundbury (St Cleer road)?

- This site of 8.8 ha. has been allocated as Open Recreation space.
- Persimmon have to spend money on creating sports pitches here as part of their planning agreement with Cornwall Council.
- We see value in making more of this and creating a high quality park with sports pitches, changing rooms and possibly a café and cycle hub (similar to at Lanhydrock).
